

STAR Interview Technique

Using the **STAR** technique in your interview will ensure that you answer any questions concisely and with a good level of detail. Use the below template to help prepare some answers for questions you would expect to hear in an interview. Possible questions could include:

- Tell me about a time you had to handle a difficult situation in the workplace.
- Describe a situation where you had to meet a tight deadline. What actions did you take?
- Can you provide an example of a time you took initiative on a project or task?
- Tell me about a time when you received critical feedback. How did you respond?



Question:	
<p>Start by setting the scene. Describe a situation where you faced a challenge or had to tackle a task. This could be anything relevant from a previous job, volunteer experience, or any relevant event.</p>	
<p>Describe what your role was in that situation. What was expected of you and what task did you have to complete?</p>	
<p>Explain what steps and actions you took to address the situation. This is where you can highlight your skills and abilities.</p>	
<p>Share the outcomes of your actions. Did you manage to resolve the situation? What did you learn? The result doesn't always have to be positive, but if it isn't, it's important to demonstrate what you learned from it.</p>
